*Harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.*

Don't insult, abuse, or harass any hacker, volunteer, or person at the hackathon. If there is an inappropriate or uncomfortable situation that makes any person feel unsafe, please tell a volunteer or organizer immediately.

Harassment includes offensive written or verbal comments related to physical appearance, body, size, sexual images in public spaces, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following harassing photography or recording, gender, sexual orientation, sustained disruption of other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention. Any participant asked to stop harassing behaviors will be asked to follow immediately. If any participant at the hackathon engages in harassing behavior, the offender may be warned or expelled from the event with no refund or reimbursement of any type.

\* Judges, organizers, mentors, sponsors, or anybody else at the event are also expected to follow the anti harassment policy. Everybody at the event should not be wearing/using sexualised clothing, costumes or uniforms to create a sexualised environment.

\* If any you or anybody else is being harassed please contact an organizer or volunteer immediately.

\* If you have any other concerns, please contact an officer or volunteer immediately.
